

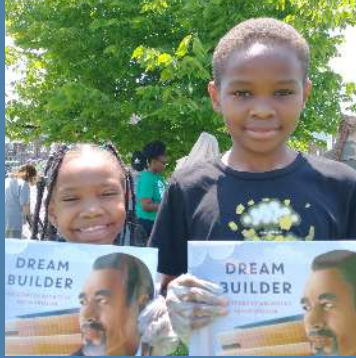

540 students & parents reached through the Family Resource Center.

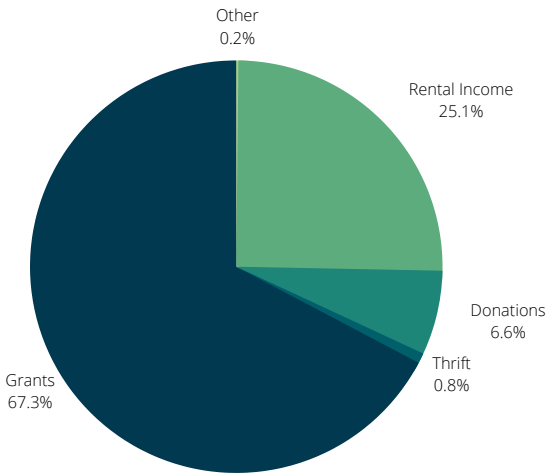
80 students served by the OCCDA After School Program.

55 children participated in the PAT program.

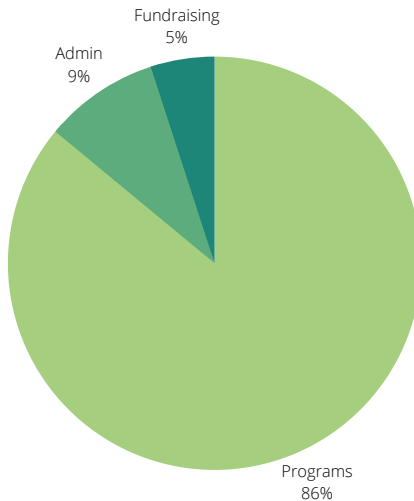
250 families participated in Community Literacy Activities.
